

USF Fulbright Symposium Featuring Anne Graham Cagney Waterford Institute of Technology & Trinity College Dublin

Join USF World as we welcome Dr. Anne Graham Cagney. Her talk titled, "Further & Adult Education in the 'Path' of the Perfect Storm" will focus on the broader context of adult and higher education in Ireland. Attendees will learn about the wave of change within adult education as a direct result of the EU and Irish government-driven policy changes in respect to teacher education qualifications and discuss American transformative learning theory as applied to internal and external learning spaces for the individual. The underlying theme of this Fulbright project is to explore how American transformative learning theory can enhance the teaching-learning environment for teachers in adult education in Ireland. Dialogue and discussion will follow the presentation.

Dr. Anne Graham Cagney is an Irish Fulbright Scholar whose research is focused on exploring how to create transformative learning spaces in professional development programs for teachers in adult education.

Professional development of teachers within further and adult education is a new initiative in Ireland. Her Fulbright experience at USF has allowed her to work closely with American faculty and researchers in the field of transformative learning to identify models and ideas of best practice.
